## Framework of Bilateral Cooperation

### ○Promoting Co-benefits approach

Based on bilateral memorandums of understanding on environmental cooperation with Asian countries, developing JCM formulation program to promote a synergistic approach to combat air pollution and climate change. By sharing Japanese knowledge and expertise and developing the capacity of government officials in partner countries, aiming to improve air, water, and soil quality and support partner countries' efforts to achieve a decarbonized society.



### Project of replacing coal fuel with biomass solid fuel made from agricultural waste

**Field:** Air Pollution

**Project Area:** Ho Chi Minh City and major areas of the Mekong Delta

**Project summary:** Preliminary Study and assess the potential GHG and air pollution reduction benefits of using rice straw as a solid fuel. Promote the replacement of coal with biomass solid fuel in the Mekong Delta region.



### Project in the Republic of India using rice straw solid fuel production

**Field:** Air Pollution

**Project Area:** Ludhiana District, Punjab

**Project Summary:** Aims to reduce air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions by introducing equipment that enables preliminary analysis and production of solid fuel from rice straw and rice husk, both agricultural residues.



### Project for the introduction of an energy-creating wastewater treatment system to the Citarum River

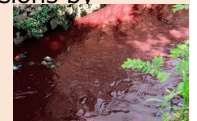
**Field:** Water Environment
